* Facilities

Academic Infrastructure:

The teaching learning facilities are the backbone of an educational institution. Despite located at fully rural area, the institution has been given utmost attention and important efforts have been being taking to build such facilities to cater the needs and requirement for a vibrant educational environment since its establishment in a phase manner. The teaching learning facilities in Brahmaputra Degree College range from physical facilities such as class room, ICT facilities, various teaching aids including the digital class room, conference hall, digital library facilities such as internet and e- learning provision etc. A brief account of such physical and material facilities can be read as under: Total number of class room of various sizes for theory classes in college is 13.

There are internet and wi-fi facilities also in the college. Teaching aids like smart board, digital board, still and moving camera and other ICT enabled aid, projector are used widely and regularly. As a part of its attempt to build healthy environment, the college has been putting sincere effort to make the library a resource center.

Hostel:

The college has limited and a single hostel building only for girls. The number of seats currently available in the girls' hostel is 80. The application form for hostel admission may be collected from the office of the college and submitted to the concerned authority. The hostel superintendent in consultation with the college authority will finalize the list of candidates on the basis of merit. Hostel will remain closed during summer vacation and semester breaks. Those admitted to the hostel will have to abide by the college hostel rules.

Canteen:

The college has a canteen for providing refreshment to students at a subsidized rate within the college premise.

Sports:

Games and Sports facilities are available in the college. There is a big open ground for practice sports near the campus of the college. A gym facility with latest equipments for students and teacher is provided by the college.

Computer:

Computer facilities including Internet are available at a nominal rate and can be availed both by the teacher and students.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1. A student shall lose /her right of admission to his/her class, if he / she fails to attend his/her classes continuously for 15 teaching days from the date of the commencement of classes.
- 2. The courses of study in Brahmaputra Degree College are full time courses. No student can take any other full time course concurrently. If any student is admitted to any other course, then the student/guardian should inform the college authority immediately and discontinue the other course if he/ she wants to continue the course at the college. Violation of this provision will lead to disciplinary action.
- 3. Students are responsible for their conduct to the Principal and are prohibited from doing anything either inside or outside the college, that amount to breach/break of discipline or interference in the discipline and normal working of the college. Students shall be liable to disciplinary action for violation of any of the rules of discipline. Disciplinary action may involve warning and/or fine, and/or suspension from the classes, from the examination, from the use of the college library or even from the college as such.

- 4. Students shall conduct themselves in decorous manner both towards the members of the staff [Teaching and Administration] and towards their fellow students .Insubordination, unbecoming language or indecorous conduct including teasing, ragging, assaulting others, etc. shall be severely dealt with.
- 5. students shall maintain perfect silence in the classroom and desist from demonstration or disorderly behavior. They must not loiter in the corridor or in front of the classroom and must keep as quiet as possible at all times.
- 6. Students shall take proper of the college property, furniture and premises and they must not spoil or damage to, or temper with the college property, furniture and fittings. They shall not litter the college campus.
- 7. Students shall leave their bicycles, scooters,/motorcycles looked in the shed provided for this purpose .No two wheelers should be parked in any other part of the college campus.
- 8. No society can be informed in the college without the permission of the Principal, nor shall any person be invited to address a meeting in the college without the prior permission of the college authority.

- 4. Using or exploiting a student.
- 5. Verbal abuse for example swear words, references to the person's appearance, attire, religion, caste, family etc.
- 6. Asking unnecessary question to the fresher's.
- 7. Using foul language.
- 8. Reading or browning pornographic/Objectionable materials.
- 9. Teasing excitement by rough or rude treatment.
- 10. Raise apprehensive fear in a fresher.
- 11. Showing or encouraging indiscipline manners.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING:

The following punishments may be taken up on an offender, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilty.

- 1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- 2. Withholding scholarship and other benefits.
- 3. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, college tournament, youth festival etc.
- 4. Withholding results.
- 5. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- 6. Cancellation of admission.
- 7. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- 8. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institutions for a specific period.
- 9. Imposing a fine up to Rs. 10,000/-

<u>DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SENIOR STUDENTS IN REGARD TO</u> RAGGING:-
